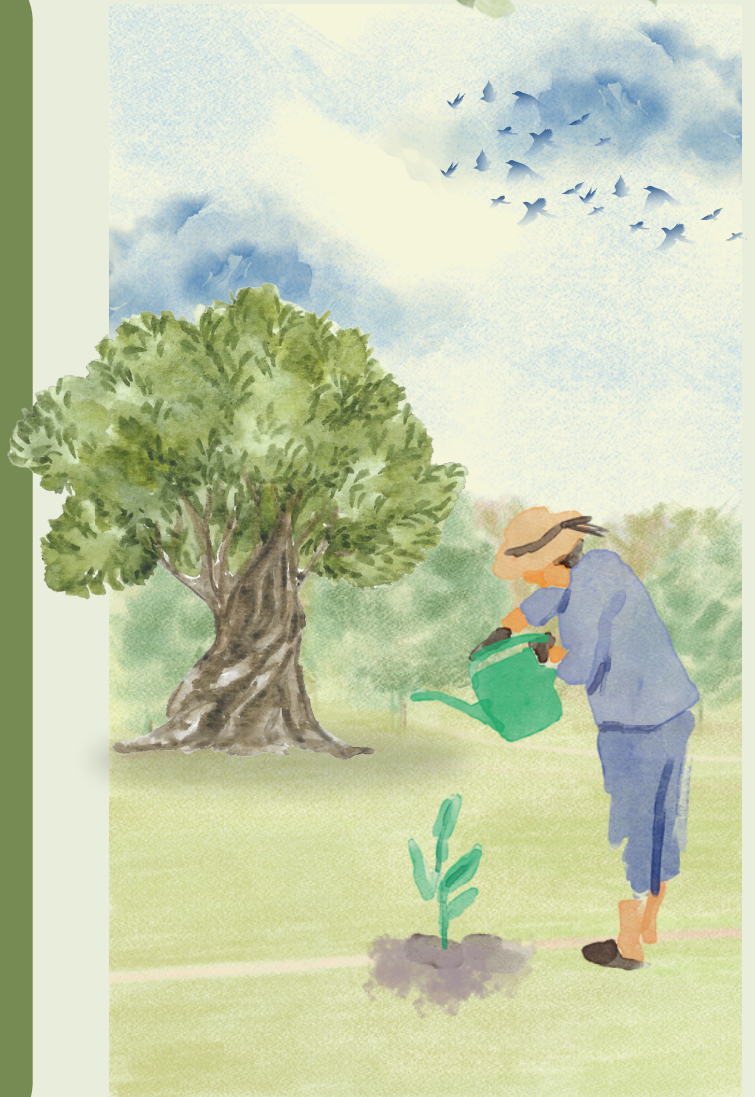
Community Coffee Morning
