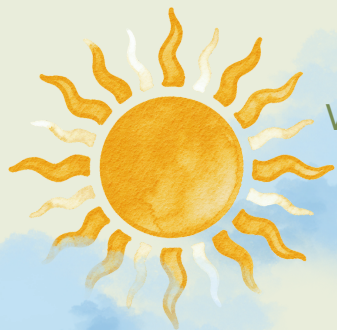
Okehampton Show - Thursday 13th August
